Maharaj J. P. Valvi Arts, Commerce and Shri V. K. K. Science College (MJPVASC), Dhadgaon, is located in the remote and hilly tribal region of the Satpuda ranges in Nandurbar district, Maharashtra. Today, the institution stands as the only senior college in the Akrani (Dhadgaon) tehsil. The college is permanently affiliated to KBC North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon, and recognized by UGC under Sections 2(f) and 12(B).
